

On every street in this seaside town, you can find shops where sculptures in stone, brass and wood are both made and sold. Take home miniature art pieces, engaging board games, or exquisitely sculpted idols as memorable keepsakes. Ranging from a foot to over seven feet, these sculptures are not just decorations but tangible tokens of Mamallapuram, documenting the spirit of this enchanting town.

MAMALLAPURAM DAZZLES WITH RAGAS AND THALAS



The 30-day Indian dance festival, organized by the Department of Tourism, Govt of Tamil Nadu, commenced at the Shore Temple in Mamallapuram on December 22, 2023, and will persist until January 21, 2024. The festival presents an array of classical and folk dance forms, including Bharathanatyam, Mohiniattam, Odissi, Kavadi, Karagattam, and Oyolattam. The open-air stage, situated against the historic background of the Pallava Rock Sculpture, attracts performers from across the country. The dancers bring to life the epics of Mahabharat, Ramayana, Shiva Shakthi, Valli Muruga, and other classic sagas.

TRAIL OF THE MONTH

CAIRN HILLS, THE NILGIRIS

Cairn Hills, situated in the environs of the Nilgiris, calls out adventure seekers for a thrilling guided trek through its expansive greenery. This 1.5-kilometre guided walk costs Rs. 200 per participant. An expedition like this assures a rejuvenating experience for both the body and mind.

While hiking through Cairn Hills, cocooned in the verdant expanse, the trek reveals dense verdure resembling a carpet and provides a peek into the teeming wildlife. Bring your binoculars along for a heightened encounter at the gateway of avian beauty, allowing you to marvel and appreciate the nuances of their flights. The hanging bridge, a favourite among kids, becomes an equally captivating adventure for grown-ups as your path guides you to its immersive attraction. Pause at the nearby watchtowers for a panoramic of Nilgiris' slopes and treat surrounding mountains, where the landscape is wrapped in a verdant cloak and enshrouded in an ethereal mist. Conclude your trek with a visit to the souvenir shop, a perfect way to bring a touch of Nilgiris' pzazz back with you. Plan your adventure during the summer for the best experience, with the trek commencing at the pleasant hour of 9 a.m.


